B.Sc. (Hons.) in Women's Health, Hygiene and Disease Prevention is a multidisciplinary undergraduate program designed to equip students with comprehensive knowledge of women's health across different stages of life. The course focuses on promoting health, preventing diseases, improving hygiene practices, and creating awareness about reproductive, maternal, adolescent, and geriatric health.

Students gain a strong foundation in anatomy, physiology, nutrition, public health, epidemiology, preventive healthcare, menstrual hygiene management, maternal and child health, communicable and non-communicable diseases, health education, and community outreach. The curriculum combines theoretical learning with practical training, field visits, health awareness campaigns, and research projects to develop professional competencies.

Graduates of this program can pursue careers in hospitals, public health organizations, NGOs, healthcare industries, research institutions, wellness centers, government health departments, and international organizations working toward women's health and empowerment. They may also continue higher studies in public health, healthcare management, nutrition, epidemiology, or related disciplines.
